01 ANTELOPE ARE CURIOUS BY NATURE

Anything can spark their interest and they will come and check it out. Antelope are also very territorial, probably one of the most territorial animals I know of



RESPOND WELL TO DECOYS 02

Antelope don't respond well to calls, but they do respond well to decoys.

03 HUNTING FROM A BLIND IS BEST OPTION

You may sit in a blind for hours seeing nothing and then all of the sudden a herd will run in at 30 yards away from you. This is much different than hunting whitetail deer as you usually see a deer coming and have time to prepare and anticipate the shot before he arrives.



PRACTICE SHOOTING BOW! 04

For shooting distances most shots take place anywhere from 30 to 40 yards, some being shorter and some being longer. The further you can shoot comfortably will increase the odds you will have at taking bigger trophy bucks.
